For those who prefer a little exercise with their relaxation, there is much on offer for guests at Lucknam Park.

The Spa

Situated within the walled garden The Spa includes a 20 metre indoor swimming pool, indoor and outdoor hydrotherapy pool, outdoor salt water plunge pool, nine state of the art treatment rooms, relaxation room, experience showers, modern fitness suite, four thermal cabins, hairdressing salon, lounge bar and The Brasserie.

Equestrian Centre

Our equestrian centre has top of the range facilities for its thirty five horses including a new cross country course, suitable for novice as well as for the more experienced rider, built by Badminton course builders the Willis Brothers, a full size all weather arena, all weather lunge penn and American barn stabling. Rides and lessons for complete beginners to experienced riders are available from our qualified instructors. Estate hacks are very popular over the 500 glorious acres of parkland and woodland Livery arrangements are also available. Other activities

- The 500 acre estate offers delightful areas for walking, jogging and cycling (hotel mountain bikes are also available).
- Stroll around Lucknam Park's beautiful gardens and arboretum.
- Enjoy tennis on one of our outdoor tennis courts with the finest synthetic grass surface available.
- Get the family together for a game of five-a-side football on our state of the art pitch with pioneering fifty millimeter artificial carpet.
- For something a little more relaxing how about a game of croquet on the lawns in front of house. The Drawing Room terrace is close by so you can finish off with a traditional afternoon tea.
- We can organise a range of other activities including Archery, Clay Pigeon Shooting and Hot Air Ballooning within the grounds. Golf and Fishing can be arranged nearby.

Bath

The historic city of Bath, famous for both Roman and Georgian influences of architecture, is just 6 miles from Lucknam Park. It is one of only two cities in Europe designated by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site, the other being Florence in Italy. It is famous for its Roman Baths, buildings and architecture, history, monuments, parks, restaurants and shops.

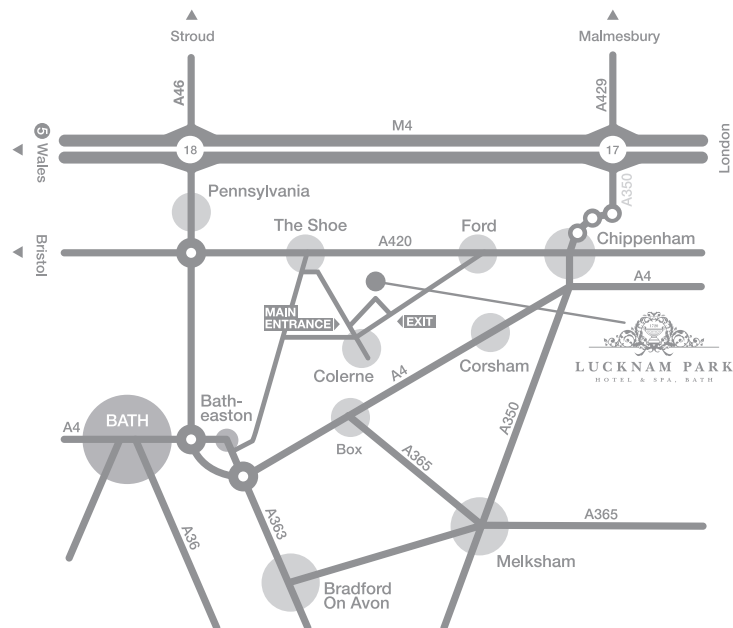

ROOM DESCRIPTIONS

Lucknam Park is a 17th Century Palladian Mansion which means all of our elegant and luxurious rooms do vary in size, shape and outlook, making them hard to classify in traditional hotel terms. However, the following may help explain some of the variations.

Standard Rooms

These double bedded rooms are situated in both the main house or around the delightful courtyard. Although these are the smallest rooms they are ideal for shorter stays.

Deluxe Rooms

These twin or double bedded medium sized rooms are situated in the main house, courtyard and cottages and have the benefit of a cosy sitting area within the room. All enjoy a lovely outlook.

Park Suites

Four individual suites situated in the courtyard and cottages. These spacious rooms all enjoy fine views of the gardens and have the luxury of a comfortable sitting area. Other features of these rooms include a DVD Player and either a four poster, sleigh bed or separate walk in shower.

Grand Suites

These traditional, luxurious suites are situated in the main house and courtyard and have stunning views across the estate and gardens. All have a DVD Player and feature either separate sitting rooms, open fire places or four poster beds.

Grand Master Suites (Coral and Tower)

Situated in the bays at the front of the main house each has magnificent views of the estate. Both these unique suites have sumptuous décor, with a large sitting area, stately four poster bed, writing desk and a dining table. Other features include a DVD Player and an open fire. Both rooms interconnect with accommodation that can be twinned.

POINTS TO NOTE

Arrivals & Departure

Bedroom accommodation is usually available from 2pm on the day of arrival. Guests arriving before this time are welcome to use the hotel facilities until their bedroom becomes available. Guests must vacate their bedroom before 12pm on day of departure, but may use the hotel facilities subject to availability.

Children

Children are warmly welcomed at Lucknam Park. Some bedrooms can accommodate an extra bed or cot, for which a charge is made. Baby-sitting can be arranged with prior notice. Children under 5 are not permitted to dine in the Park restaurant in the evening but are welcome to dine in The Brasserie which is open for all day dining and offers great kiddies menus. All children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult when using the Spa facilities. A number of our rooms are interconnecting making them ideal for families with young children.

Easier Access

The hotel has one bedroom specifically accessible for wheelchairs. There are also a number of other ground floor rooms both in the Main House and the Courtyard. Please advise on booking if you require an easier access room.

Dietary requirements

Should you have any specific dietary needs, please advise at the time of booking.

Dress Code

The dress code for dinner in The Park restaurant is jacket required, tie preferred, no denim or trainers.

Dogs

Dogs and other pets cannot be accepted at the hotel. Kennelling is available nearby.

Helicopters

Helicopters may land within the estate provided prior notice is given.

Mobile phones

Guests are requested not to use mobile phones in public areas including Drawing Room, Library, Front Hall, Restaurant and Spa.

Smoking

Lucknam Park adheres to a legal requirement of no smoking throughout the hotel. A comfortable smoking sanctuary is available close to the hotel overlooking the Arboretum.

DINING

The Park

Traditional and elegant, located in the main house with lovely views over the estate.

For dinner and Sunday lunch reservations are required to avoid disappointment.

The Brasserie

Contemporary and stylish, located within The Spa's walled garden setting, The Brasserie provides informal all day dining including breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Reservations for lunch and dinner are not essential but recommended if you would like to dine at a specific time. Special dietary requirements are catered for on request.
