



Please note: Equestrian experiences will not be booked until we have received the completed Risk Assessment form.

Rider's weight: we have a strict weight limit of 224 lbs / 16st / 102kg

Important Information

Equipment included: We provide the following equipment: helmets, boots & chaps. Please bring gloves, jacket/s and waterproof clothing with you for inclement weather. It is a good idea to wear supportive, close-fitting clothing. Bring supportive outdoor footwear if attending a groundwork family session or walking out on foot with your child on a Pony Trail. If you have equipment of your own, please note that it must comply with the current standards.

Coaching Sessions: Are for experienced riders & incorporate an initial assessment of suitability. We classify an experienced novice as someone who can maintain control of the horse in trot & canter with a balanced, independent seat. This is at the instructor's discretion. If the instructor feels it is unsafe to proceed at a certain level, they will alter the session/horse to meet the rider's capability. These guidelines are to ensure the welfare, safety, and satisfaction of our riders. Children under 14 years must be accompanied by a parent or guardian for the entire duration of their activity. Maximum weight limit of 13 stone.

Jumping Experience: All jumping lessons are for experienced riders, minimum of 10 years & incorporate an initial assessment of suitability. This is at the instructor's discretion. If the instructor feels it is unsafe to proceed, they will alter the session/horse to meet the riders capability. These guidelines are to ensure the welfare, safety and satisfaction of our riders. Children under 14 years must be accompanied by a parent or guardian for the entire duration of their activity. Maximum weight limit of 13 stone.

Bookings: Must be made at least 24 hours prior to arrival. We cannot guarantee last minute bookings.

Cancellation policy: It is the policy of the Equestrian Centre to charge full payment for equestrian experiences that are cancelled with less than 24 hours' notice of the experience. I understand if I arrive late for my session my riding time may be cut short or my riding session may not be able to go ahead and I will be charged in full.

Adverse or unsafe weather conditions: In times of adverse or unsafe riding conditions your equestrian experience may have to be cancelled or postponed at late notice and you will receive a refund in full and we will endeavour to rebook if possible. To check that your ride is going ahead, call hotel reception by 9.15am the day of your ride: 01225 742777
